



## Updated COVID Guidelines - Temple Beth Torah

Updated September 6, 2022

### General Guidelines

- All members and visitors to TBT (over 6 months old) must be up to date with their COVID vaccinations and boosters (or have pre-approved medical exemption).
- All attendees and visitors indoors (over 2yrs) must wear masks.
  - Except while eating or drinking
- Outdoors, masks are suggested but not required.
- Upon arrival, please sign in at the registration table.
- Families with unvaccinated children under 6 months old in attendance, please socially distance.
- Most services will have an online option, and links will be noted in the weekly emails.

### Service Guidelines

- Service leaders may be unmasked while leading the service at least 6 feet from attendees and each other (single leader and one soloist only).
- Sanctuary will be set up with extra spacing between rows. Congregants can seat themselves as desired.
- Seat cards will be available for “empty seat” request.
- Food and drink may be set out in the social hall for after services. These items may be consumed either indoors or out, in compliance with above masking guidelines.

### Meetings/Events Guidelines

- Meetings with < or = 10 attendees may unanimously agree to have masks optional (those who want to keep them on are more than welcome to).
